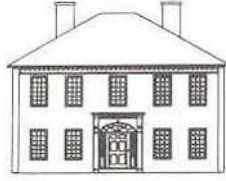

Twenty-Eighth Annual Country Harvest Fair

The Holliston Historical Society, located on Route 16 in Holliston, Massachusetts, invites you to participate in our twenty-eighth annual old fashioned Country Harvest Fair. Thousands of people look forward to the annual antiques and crafts fair on the picturesque lawn of the Historical Society which is traditionally held in September.

If you would like to take part again, or join us for the first time, please read on and return the attached application and fee as soon as possible to reserve your spot.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$60 per space
SPACE: to be included with the attached application/agreement form
10' x10'. Dealers must supply their own tables, chairs and/or set ups. No electrical hook-ups.
FOOD: Complimentary 1 cup coffee and donut (chit available at sign in.)
Hot food and drinks available for purchase in the barn. Bake table and Society homemade pies for sale, too. Bathrooms available.

SET UP TIME: 7:30 – 9:30 AM. Upon arrival, all dealers must check in, unload their vehicles and move them to the permanent parking lot **before** setting up. We ask for your full cooperation in this matter, not only to eliminate confusion, but also as a safety precaution for arriving dealers and the public, who tend to wander the grounds before the fair has officially opened.

PARKING: Because of the number of dealer cars involved and to assist the public in finding parking, we must insist that all dealers park their cars behind the police station (directly across the street) or at a nearby designated lot. There will be assistants to guide you. Two handicap spaces have been set aside. Washington Street is a very well traveled road and the spaces directly in front of the fair need to be reserved for the buying public.

RESERVATIONS: We have space for approximately 100 dealers. Repeat dealers will be given preference for their number space. We will try very hard not to put like crafts next to one another. Reservations should be received by August 1, 2008 with full payment.

REMINDER: This is an old-fashioned country fair. Please, no commercial or wholesale products! Hand Crafted Items Only!! Exhibitors with commercial products will be asked to leave and will not be invited back for future fairs.

NEW ENGLAND CRAFTS ONLY. Although we have been trying to avoid this restriction, we find that so many crafts being sold are not homemade, and so we must insist that you verify that your crafts are made in New England. Exceptions will be granted for all dealers who have been with us in previous years and have been approved. These dealers will be subject to all other conditions of this application.

FAIR CANCELLATION DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER: Should **BOTH DATES** be canceled, a maximum of \$30.00 per space will be refunded to each dealer. The Historical Society is non-profit organization and since this is our only major fund raiser for the year, we would suffer a substantial loss, not only from the cancellation of the fair, but also from our inability to recoup the money we had invested in the fair. Please check our recorded message (updated at 5:30 AM the day of the fair) as conditions in Holliston may be different from your home location.

LIABILITY: The Holliston Historical Society shall not be held responsible for any loss, property damage, or bodily harm.

ACCEPTANCE: When your application is received and accepted, your check will be deposited and your canceled check will serve as your acceptance until some time in August when acceptance letters are mailed out. If all spaces are sold out, your check will be returned and your name will be put on a waiting list to be notified if a space becomes available.
